

We have been challenged!

OMNI NANO is filling a gap in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) education.

The science curriculum currently taught in schools is incredibly out of date and students are rarely taught what is relevant in the 21st Century. Our nanotechnology programs fill this void. We have already brought Discover Nanotechnology workshops to 80 different schools, reaching over 5,500 students. This program gives students a one-day introduction to nanotechnology but we are ready to take it to the next level.

Nanotechnology is a cutting edge field that has enabled some of the biggest advancements to date in a multitude of areas. Everything from touch screen computers and phones, to batteries that last long enough to make an electric car possible, to targeted cancer treatments with higher success rates all credit their capabilities to nano materials and nanotechnology.

We now have requests to work with dozens of high schools across the country to offer the first ever nanotechnology science class. With these first schools, we will give 8,000 students the opportunity to take our cutting edge course, and have the opportunity to expand to all 13,000 school districts in the US - offering Nanotechnology to a potential 3.5 million students each year. These dozens of schools want to start right away, but only half of our program is complete.

We still need \$50,000 to finish the first edition of the curriculum.

If we raise \$25,000, the Confidence Foundation will match that!

This is a critical hurdle to overcome, which will jumpstart our roadmap to updating high school curriculum across the nation, capturing the interest of today's youth.

1. All funds shall be restricted to purpose set forth above. Any modification of the use of these funds must be approved in writing by the Foundation. In awarding this grant, the Foundation is not committing to any additional support of the Grantee in the future.
2. In compliance with Federal Tax Law, the Grantee agrees to sign and return the receipt of contribution form within ten (10) days of receipt.
3. Any portion of the Grant not expended for completion of the specific purpose or for an approved modification, shall be returned in full to the Confidence Foundation.
